# GENERAL GUIDELINES/REQUIREMENTS

**All students enrolled in virtual online learning must:**

- Have access to reliable WiFi on a daily basis
- Have access to a reliable device to livestream daily lessons and complete all assignments via Google Classroom
- If a device is needed, the school will provide one; a parent/student [Chromebook agreement form](#) must be completed and signed prior to Aug. 25
- Enroll in the school's **REMIND Group** for updates & regular communication

# LOGIN INFORMATION

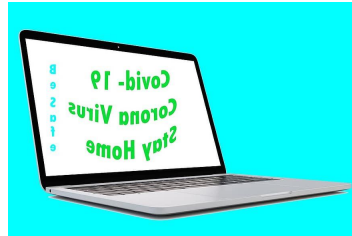
All students registered for virtual learning will use their student email and password to access Google Classroom in each of their scheduled classes

# LOGIN REQUIREMENTS

## **WHEN SCHOOL IS IN SESSION (8:15-3:15)**

All students are expected to login to his or her daily classes via Google Classroom

All students are expected to participate in virtual live streaming (Google Meet or Zoom) of daily lessons in all assigned classes

If no activity for two (2) days, a teacher or CIS online facilitator will contact you

If you are going to be absent for one or more classes on any given day, please contact (email or phone) the school AND email your teachers

# ESSENTIAL ENROLLMENTS

All students and parents/guardians are expected to enroll in the CHS or CMS Remind Group for school updates and communication

**\*For CHS students/parents**, this will be done at curbside registration on Aug. 17-20

**\*For CMS students/parents**, this will be done at Back to School Info Sessions on Aug. 17-18

All students and parents/guardians will be placed in a virtual communication group through the district's ONE CALL system as well



# ATTENDANCE

All virtual students are expected to login on a daily basis in each of his or her classes in order to be counted present for the class/day

Two (2) days without any online activity in classes will result in a contact from a teacher or our district's online facilitator

If a student is going to be absent from virtual learning for ANY reason, the parent/guardian must email the teacher(s) and reason for absence in advance or within two (2) days for the absence to be excused

If parent/guardian communication is not received in advance or within two (2) days after the absence, the day(s) will be counted as an **unexcused absence**

Three (3) or more unexcused absences--DPP contact

\*Excessive absenteeism from virtual learning may result in switching back in in-person classes\*

# HONORS/INTERVENTION

Students who have a Gifted Plan will continue to receive GT services through his or her regular education teacher

Students with an IEP will continue to receive services with his or her respective special education teacher virtually on: **Google Meet or Zoom**

These virtual meetings will be set up by the SPED teachers with the students who receive these services according to their IEPs

# SPECIAL EDUCATION

It is the Caverna Independent School District's priority to ensure that students with disabilities have equal access to the same opportunities as their non-disabled peers. IEPs will continue to be developed and implemented based upon each student's unique needs and the learning environment chosen by the family.

Accommodations and modifications will be provided regardless of a student's learning environment. General and special education teachers will continue to collaborate in determining the appropriateness and success of a student's accommodations and/or modifications.

The IEP team (general education teachers, special education, related services providers, and families) will work collaboratively to identify alternate solutions if it believes an accommodation and/or modification is not appropriate or successful in a particular setting. Special Education teachers will be in contact daily with students after the direct instruction has been delivered.



# AFTER SCHOOL SUPPORT

ESS services will be offered virtually to students who request extra assistance and/or support in his or her classes
